We suggest that the length of each performance should be no longer than 3 minutes for solos performances and 3-4 minutes for couples or groups unless agreed in advance with the organisers. This is so we can schedule the event and ensure as many members as possible have the opportunity to participate.

We are particularly looking for an entertaining exhibition programmes which reflects the theme of the 'MOVIE' that has been chosen. The use of appropriate costumes is encouraged rather than a competition performance.

Entries must be in by 12.00noon on Sunday 26th January 2020. Separate applications forms are required for each separate performance if participating on solo and group numbers.

Skaters must supply their own music which must be on CD. Only the music for that performance must be on the CD which must be clearly marked with the name of the PERFORMANCE and the music being skated to.

Skater or skater(s) names and group name can also be on the CD

Please ensure you have a spare good quality copy of the music on the day (at rink side).

By entering the event you agree to your photograph being taken and being videoed by the club. These will be used for publicity, sales and the club web site. Unauthorised photography/recording of any skater or part of the event **is not** permitted. The club as the organisers of the event will be regarded as the authors of the work and as such are copyright owners and "All rights reserved". **Flash Photography is not permitted during the event**. This is for the protection of the skaters as this is dangerous and distracting.
